• OLD BUSINESS:

- Status of Audit ongoing. Auditor not present.
- Hopewell Township Shared Services Agreement Chairman discussed status of Agreement. No progress; township still working on it..
- Old First Aid Building Attorney Appleby discussed at length the revisions to the proposed Use and Occupancy Agreement with the Borough for use of part of the First Aid Building. The Chairman will approach the Borough to try to finalize the Agreement.
- Tanker replacement and communications from Hopewell Township. The Chief discussed meeting with different manufacturers as to the tanker. Prices were up to about \$1 million, up significantly from last year. Discussion as to the process for capital purchases and need for voter approval if financing and possible special election. Hopewell Township would also need to have voter approval, since they contribute towards cost.
- Commercial properties and Township Fire Marshall. Common call under control. Township Commissioner to discuss with hospital regarding internal communications. Trapped in elevator and couldn't talk to each other. Discussion about the fire land and use for valet parking. Not sure if resolved.
- Election. Deadline for placement on ballot.

• NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion as to American Rescue Grant and need to pass a resolution to add to the budget. Assistant Chief advised that there is a matching amount for the grant. Attorney will amend the resolution to include the necessary language for the matching funds and line items.
