RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS BETWEEN LINE ITEMS IN 2019 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the voters in Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1 in the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, approved line item operating appropriations in the 2019 fire district budget; and

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that expenditures incurred during 2019 will exceed the sums appropriated in certain line items; and

WHEREAS, there are excess funds remaining in other operating appropriations in the 2019 budget available to offset the insufficiencies in these line items; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:14-78.10 authorizes a Fire District during the first two months of any fiscal year to transfer amounts in the budget for the immediate preceding fiscal year from operating line items with excess appropriations to those with appropriations deemed to be insufficient;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1 in the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that

In the 2019 Fire District Budget transfers from the following line items with excess appropriations to those with insufficient appropriations are approved as follows:

1. \$ 79.00 from Radio Equipment to FF Equipment
2. \$ 3,588.00 from Education and Training to FF Equipment
3. \$ 4,130.00 from Turnout Gear to FF Equipment
4. \$ 5,878.00 from Turnout Gear to FF & Radio Repairs and Maint.
5. \$ 3,187.00 from Turnout Gear to Truck Repair
6. \$ 4,220.00 from Insurance to FF Equipment
7. \$ 54.00 from Insurance to Elections
8. \$ 1,830.00 from Insurance to FF & Radio Repairs and Maint.
9. \$ 7.00 from Insurance to Education & Training
10. \$ 375.00 from Insurance to Hazardous Material
11. \$ 108.00 from Insurance to Office Services
12. \$ 1,223.00 from Operating Supplies to Subscription & Advertising
13. \$ 100.00 from Operating Supplies to Hazardous Material
