RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS BETWEEN LINE ITEMS IN 2020 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the voters in Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1 in the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, approved line item operating appropriations in the 2020 fire district budget; and

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that expenditures incurred during 2020 will exceed the sums appropriated in certain line items; and

WHEREAS, there are excess funds remaining in other operating appropriations in the 2020 budget available to offset the insufficiencies in these line items; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:14-78.10 authorizes a Fire District during the first two months of any fiscal year to transfer amounts in the budget for the immediate preceding fiscal year from operating line items with excess appropriations to those with appropriations deemed to be insufficient;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1 in the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that

In the 2020 Fire District Budget transfers from the following line items with excess appropriations to those with insufficient appropriations are approved as follows:

1. \$ 9,000.00 from Gas and Oil to FF Equipment
2. \$ 8,000.00 from Education and Training to FF Equipment
3. \$ 1,000.00 from Medical to FF Equipment
4. \$ 2,000.00 from Professional Services to FF Equipment
5. \$ 19,000.00 from Insurance to FF Equipment
6. \$ 130.00 from Insurance to Radio Equipment
7. \$ 1,100.00 from Rent to Radio Equipment
8. \$ 970.00 from Elections to Radio Equipment
9. \$ 1,900.00 from Truck Repairs to Radio Equipment
10. \$ 1,000.00 from Operating Supplies to Radio Equipment
11. \$ 1,000.00 from FF & Radio Repair to Radio Equipment
11. \$ 1,000.00 from Professional Services to Turn-out Gear
12. \$ 1,900.00 from Telephone to Turn-out Gear
13. \$ 1,600.00 from Subscriptions & Advertising to Turn-out Gear
